El examen de admisión está basado en la bibliografía utilizada por los alumnos de 6to grado durante el ciclo lectivo 2021.

Libro: Project 3 – 4th edition – Oxford University Press – Student's book y Workbook.

#### **Cuentos:**

#### **Contenidos lingüísticos:**
